Current Situation

- 2024-25 School Year Budget Projection: \$6.5M assuming a
 2% increase
- Projected Gap: Approximately \$300,000 (if we remain at 2%)
- Increased Costs: Liability insurance, increased staffing, salary increases, health benefits, transportation, special education costs and related services
- **State Aid Update:** Decrease of \$70,667, a decrease of 12.9%, mostly due to exiting the School Choice program



Why Are We Facing a Budget Gap?

- General Liability Insurance
 - Rates increased by 16% (\$12,400)
- Increased staff hiring over the last three years
 - Maintain small class sizes (two sections per grade) in grades K-8 (5th grade has one section)
 - · Hired intervention staff to better support student needs
 - · Introduced a class three officer.
 - · Hired a ML Teacher required due to the number of Multilingual learners
 - Hired in house paraprofessionals and the number of special education teachers to better support student needs.
- Salary increases
 - **2.5**% (\$97,500) increase for staff (per QEA Contract)
- Rise in health benefits
 - **9%** (\$83,750) Increase
- Increased costs for transportation
 - **6%**(\$23,700) Increase
- Rise in Special Education Costs Related Services and CST
 - **14.7**% (\$165,700) Increase

Additional Considerations

Projected Budget Gap: \$300,000

Based on a 2% tax levy increase (standard).

Impact of a Flat Budget:

0% increase expands gap to: \$427,468.

Administration Recommendation:

- Utilize banked cap for a 6.67% increase.
- Ensures maintenance of current staffing levels.

Budget Increase Equivalence:

• Each 1% increase equals \$64,044 in funding.

2% Increase	A potential reduction of 4-5 staff members
3% Increase	A potential reduction of 3-4 staff members
4% Increase	A potential reduction of 2-3 staff members
5% Increase	A potential reduction of 1-2 staff members
6.67% Increase	No staff reductions - Keep the current level of service including small class sizes.

Budget Increase Equivalence:

• Each 1% increase equals \$64,044 in funding.
