#### Α. Resolution Appointing Financial Adviser

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PROPOSAL FOR CERTAIN FINANCIAL ADVISORY SERVICES ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN IN THE COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, NEW **JERSEY** 

WHEREAS, there exists a need for specialized financial advisory services in connection with the authorization and the issuance of Refunding School Bonds by The Board of Education of the Township of Franklin in the County of Hunterdon, New Jersey (the "Board"), a body corporate of the State of New Jersey, including the review and compilation of financial and demographic information of the School District; obtaining the appropriate credit enhancements for the refunding bonds; structuring the various terms and conditions associated with the refunding bonds in order to maximize the interest savings; and general advice to the Board about the various financial aspects of the refinancing; and

WHEREAS, the Board obtained two proposals for such services and selected a proposal that had the most competitive price—i.e., Phoenix Advisors, LLC; and

WHEREAS, the firm of Phoenix Advisors, LLC, Bordentown City, New Jersey is recognized by the financial community to have the specialized financial advisory experience necessary to the refinance of the Board's bonds; and

WHEREAS, funds are or will be available for this purpose;

## BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF FRANKLIN IN THE COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, NEW JERSEY AS FOLLOWS:

1. The firm of Phoenix Advisors, LLC, Bordentown City, New Jersey is hereby retained to provide specialized financial advisory services necessary in connection with the authorization and the issuance of refunding bonds by the Board in accordance with a Proposal submitted to the Board (the "Proposal") dated December 13, 2012.

- 2. The Proposal is awarded without competitive bidding in accordance with N.J.S.A. 18A:18-5(a)(2) because such services are considered extraordinary and unspecifiable in their nature.
- 3. A copy of this resolution as well as the Proposal shall be placed on file with the Secretary of the Board.

#### APPOINTING BOND COUNSEL - Ronald Ianoale

WHEREAS, there exists the need for the "Professional Services" of BOND COUNSEL, to be retained by the Board of Education to prepare necessary bond ordinances and related documentation for the re- issuance of bonds and related duties associated therewith as directed by the authorized representatives of the Franklin Township Board of Education, as more specifically set forth in the Professional Services Agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A.40A:11-1, et seq. requires that the Resolution authorizing the award of contracts for "Professional Services" without competitive bids must be publicly advertised; and

WHEREAS, Ronald Ianoale of the firm of McManimon, Scotland & Baumann, LLC has completed and submitted a Business Entity Disclosure Certification which certifies that Ronald Ianoale of the firm of McManimon, Scotland & Baumann, LLC, will not make any reportable contributions pursuant to N.J.S.A.19:44A-1 et seq. commencing January 1, 2013 to any political committee or candidate through the term of this contract in excess of reportable limits:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Education of the Township of Franklin, County of Hunterdon and State of New Jersey, as follows:

- 1. That the allegations of the preamble hereto are incorporated herein as if fully set forth.
- 2. That Ronald Ianoale of the firm of McManimon, Scotland & Baumann, LLC, is a qualified bond counsel authorized to practice in the State of New Jersey, be appointed Board of Education Bond Counsel for Franklin Township for the year 2013 to perform professional services ordinarily provided by bond counsel, and he shall receive such compensation as may be reasonable for said services billed at \$195 per hour not to exceed \$20,000; and.

- 3. That the aforesaid contract is awarded without competitive bidding as a "Professional Service" under the provisions of the Local Public Contracts Law because N.J.S.A.40A:11-5 states that no local unit shall be required to advertise for bids for services rendered or performed by a person authorized by law to practice a recognized profession and whose practice is regulated by law, or to advertise for bids for services which are of such a qualitative nature as will not reasonably permit the drawing of specifications or the receipt of competitive bids, all of which classification the aforesaid contract falls within.
- 4. The Business Entity Disclosure Certification shall be placed on file with this Resolution.
- 5. All professional fees contained within the aforementioned contract will be included within the adopted 2013 budget to be certified by the Chief Financial Officer upon adoption of the 2013 budget.
- 6. That a copy of the specific items pertaining to the award of this contract shall be published in a Notice of Award in the News of Hunterdon County as required by law within ten (10) days of the Resolution authorizing same;
