FRANKLIN TOWNSHIP BOARD OF EDUCATION

COMMUNITY EDUCATION PROGRAMS

File Code: 1601

The board recognizes the value of adult educational and enrichment programs for the benefit of the community. It is the purpose of this policy to delineate the procedures necessary for the implementation of approved community education programs. Programs shall be open to Franklin Township residents nineteen years of age and older only.

All community education programs conducted at the school shall be determined and approved by the board. The board establishes the following rules for the sponsorship and conduct of community education programs upon the recommendation of the chief school administrator:

- a. Enrollment shall be determined by the board;
- b. Appropriate fee schedules shall be determined by and paid to the board;
- c. All programs, curricula, staffing, certification, scheduling, and expenditures, etc. shall be approved by the board and reviewed periodically;
- d. Use of the facilities must be in compliance with board policy and existing regulations;
- e. Appointing and contracting of an instructor shall be approved by the board.

The chief school administrator will promulgate appropriate regulations for the efficient implementation of approved programs.
