## SUBJECT FIELDS

The board of education directs that the district schools offer comprehensive curriculum to provide for the intellectual, social and emotional growth of all district pupils, giving them the basic body of skills, understandings, and knowledge needed for living in a democracy.

The board believes the district's educational program should focus first on those subjects included in the New Jersey Student Learning Standards and the skills emphasized by the 21<sup>st</sup> Century Life and Careers Standards, in addition to those courses mandated by statute.

The chief school administrator shall direct development of and present to the board for adoption a written curriculum for each element of the instructional program for the district to include all courses mandated by New Jersey statute or administrative code;

The total curriculum, when adopted, shall be adapted to suit the applicable requirements of the administrative code and shall provide basic, advanced, enriched, or technical instruction or experience to meet the identified needs of the pupils of the district.
