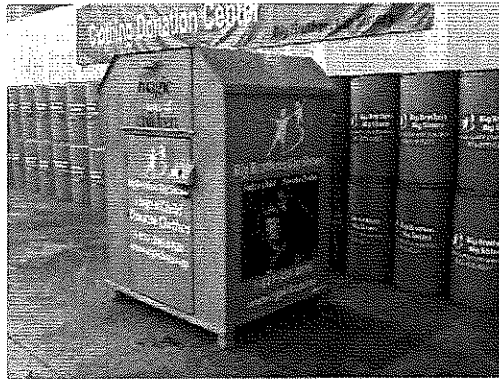

We are excited to share with you the interest in starting a noncompetitive running program in our elementary school. The purpose of the iRun4Life organization is to combat childhood obesity through activities that promote youth fitness. The children run relay races, practice endurance running, and ultimately train for a goal race. Currently, over 20 schools and 2,200 students participate in iRun4Life running programs which focus on healthy nutrition and doing good deeds in our community.
